Class updates;

Willow- This week in PE, we had fun with the parachute! We played lots of parachute games including working as a team to make a Mexican wave with the parachute. On Monday morning, the children took part in European Days of Languages where they moved around different classes in a carousel of activities learning Spanish, Romanian and German. The children in Willow Class have been working really hard in Phonics to learn lots of new sounds and the Year 2 children have been working hard to learn lots of new spellings. Well done Willow Class for all of your hard work.

This week in Maple Class we have continued our Geography work on Climate Zones by looking more closely at climate graphs for an arid climate in Cairo, Egypt. In Science we had fun using ear gongs and metre sticks to investigate how sound travels differently through different mediums. In English we began our final drafts of our wishing stories and in Maths we have been looking at rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 100. We also enjoyed languages day earlier in the week, exploring Romanian, Greek and Spanish.

Silver Birch have been busy completing their first set of PIXL assessments this week. During the mornings, we have been checking our understanding of reading comprehension, grammar, punctuation and spelling, arithmetic and reasoning. On Monday morning, we completed a carousel of activities for Languages Day. During the morning, we travelled around each class to explore different languages such as German, Spanish and Romanian.
