It was really pleasing this week to look at the work that the children have been completing in their maths across this term. During Autumn 1 we have a focus on number and place value particularly. Children use physical resources, then place value grids through to more formal methods to work out calculations of increasing complexity as they move through the school. Class updates;

Willow class have been learning about their 5 senses this week. In Science the children explored their sense of touch. We had lots of feely bags with different items and objects in them and the children had to use their sense of touch to guess what the object might be.

Maple class have been busy comparing Climate Zones in Geography, exploring addition and subtraction in maths and letter writing/recounts in English. In art we have continued our work on using lines to create art by exploring texture and patterns. In PE, we have developed our team work skills, combining what we have learned about positioning passing and shooting.

Silver Birch class have been learning about collage. We learnt that a collage describes both the technique and the resulting work of art in which pieces of paper, photographs and fabric are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface. For our lesson, we were given a black and white photograph of ourselves and we had to find different pieces of coloured paper to create a coloured replica. In Science, we investigated how materials can keep things cold or hot. For this experiment, we had two jacket potatoes that had been cooked in the oven. We then covered one with tin foil and left the other in the open air. We discovered that the potato wrapped in tin foil contained its heat for much longer whereas the other potato began to lose its heat very rapidly.
